## **Darkhorse Sewer Systems and Service**

Darkhorse is served by the Nevada County Sanitation District No. 1, Zone 2, which operates the Lake of the Pines wastewater treatment plant. There are connection fees for each residence and a yearly maintenance fee paid through property taxes. Each developed Darkhorse property must have a gravity sewer collection system in place to deliver wastewater to the pressurized sewer line under the street. Gravity sewer collection systems are maintained by the property owner. Three systems are specified by Nevada County for use in Darkhorse:

- Orenco Systems model P20. These are for use at lots #143-152, 172-178, 181-183 and 190-191. For product information, please visit

It is recommended that holding tanks with Orenco equipment be pumped out every five years. The system can be serviced by local firms that specialize in septic tank pumping, installation, and repair
- E/One Pressure Sewer System (also known as a "grinder pump"). These are for use
